Crash Trend

February to April




The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which has multiple members selected.

From February 1st to April 30th, WPD responded to an average of 84 accidents per month. This is a 13.5% increase from Q1's average.

Despite the increase in crashes, WPD officers have also increased the number of traffic enforcement efforts, conducting an average of 547 traffic stops per month.






There were 89 total vehicle crashes in the month of April, with 47 Accident Reports completed. 42 accidents were non-reportable.

The highest crash hour in April was 4pm.

Sector 3 had the highest number of crashes at 34 for the month, followed by Sector 4, 1, then 2.




In the month of April, there were 546 total traffic stops, resulting in 255 Citations, 261 Warnings, 15 with No Enforcement, and 15 Arrests. There were also 13 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Expired Registration, No Inspection, Failure to Obery Highway Sign/Marking, and Holding Phone While Operating Vehicle.

Top Reasons for Traffic Stops








Winchester Police Department April Distracted Driving Heat Map
